**FINAL Show Newsletter – March 23, 2019**

*It's hard to believe how quickly the past 11 weeks have flown by and even harder to fathom the dedication and talent our skaters have brought to the ice each week! The excitement is palpable and – at long last – it's finally SHOWTIME! I cannot wait to see our skaters shine! 😊* Some things to know:

**Costumes:** *If you are missing costume parts or have questions, please see Linda Filiau today.*

**All Skate Numbers:** *If your skater is participating in the "Royal Parade" (1<sup>st</sup> half of the show), they need to provide their own costume. Girls and boys can dress as any Disney prince or princess; costume must be safe for skating, with no loose parts. If your child is planning to wear a crown or tiara, it must be SECURELY attached to their head with bobby pins or other anchoring accessories. If your skater is participating in the "Peanuts" All-Skate (2<sup>nd</sup> half), you'll provide their costume (strongly encourage Woodstocks; otherwise, any character but Charlie Brown or Snoopy). Questions? See me today!*

**Parent Passes:** *Available for purchase today at the show table! One pass gets one parent into two shows. Tickets for all other family members can be purchased at the show table today or at the door.*

**Set Up Day:** *If you volunteered to help unload the lighting truck, please be at the JFK by 8:00 a.m. on Friday, 3/29. We will be at the rink until at least 8:00 pm on set-up day. Come lend a hand throughout the day!*

**PROFESSIONAL PHOTOS:** *Our professional photographer, Toshi Takehide, will be here to take photos of your skater(s) the morning of the show – on ice and in costume! There are only a few slots still available; sign up today! See show table for brochure and details!*

**Show T-Shirts:** *If you pre-ordered/paid for a t-shirt, they'll be at the rink on Friday and Saturday. **There are still folks who owe for their t-shirts. Payment must be made this weekend at the table!** Missed the order deadline? We'll have a very limited number of shirts available for sale at the show @\$15.*

**Skate Guards:** *Please LABEL your child's guards clearly before show day!*

**Makeup:** *Skaters are encouraged to wear appropriate stage makeup; see your coach for details.*

**Food and Beverages:** *Skaters will not be allowed to have food that can stain or colored beverages while in costume. Please provide only clear beverages/non-staining snacks!*

**Show Day:** *Saturday, 3/30; please be at the rink NO LATER than 12:30 for the 1:00 pm show and 6:30 pm for the 7:00 show. All skaters are expected to participate in both shows. Questions? Please see me!*

**Flowers:** *Bouquets will be available for sale at both shows for \$7 (small) or \$10 (large) each!*
